Proposed Parks Maintenance and Recreation Improvement Assessment (Assessment No. 1)**

The tabulation of all official ballots received by the close of the balloting period for the Fulton-El Camino Recreation and Park District's proposed Parks Maintenance and Recreation Improvement Assessment, has been completed by the Secretary of the Board of Directors of the Fulton-El Camino Recreation and Park District.

The Secretary of the Board hereby certifies the following tabulation totals for the ballots that were received by the close of the public input portion of the public hearing on July 21, 2011. In summary, on an unweighted basis, 74.39 % of the valid ballots received were in support of the proposed assessments, and on the official weighted basis, 68.43 % of the ballots, weighted by the assessment amounts, were in support.

The total number of ballots received by the end of the public input portion of the public hearing held on July 21, 2011 was 1,920. This represents a 29.93 % ballot return rate on the 6,415 ballots mailed.
